5 Distribution of Points by Admissions Criteria

1) General criteria

- (1) Those who are absent will be disqualified.
- (2) Those who do not meet the qualifications or submit false documents or engage in other dishonest acts will be disqualified regardless of their grades, and their admission will be canceled even after admission (however, tuition fees already paid will be refunded in accordance with the Ministry of Education Ordinance).

2) Selection criteria for successful applicants

- (1) A certain number of applicants will be selected based on the total score ranking among those who passed the document screening and oral examination.
- (2) Those with the same score will be prioritized according to the following rankings:
 - ① Those with higher oral examination scores
 - ② Those with higher document screening scores
- (3) Those who do not have an average oral examination score (scores per committee member) of 60 points or more than 2/3 of the oral examination committee members give a score of less than 40 points will be disqualified.
- (4) Those who lack academic performance will not be selected regardless of the number of applicants.
